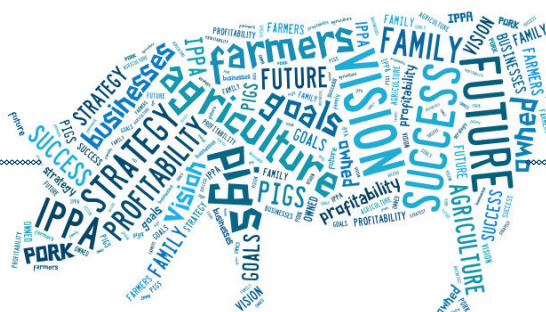

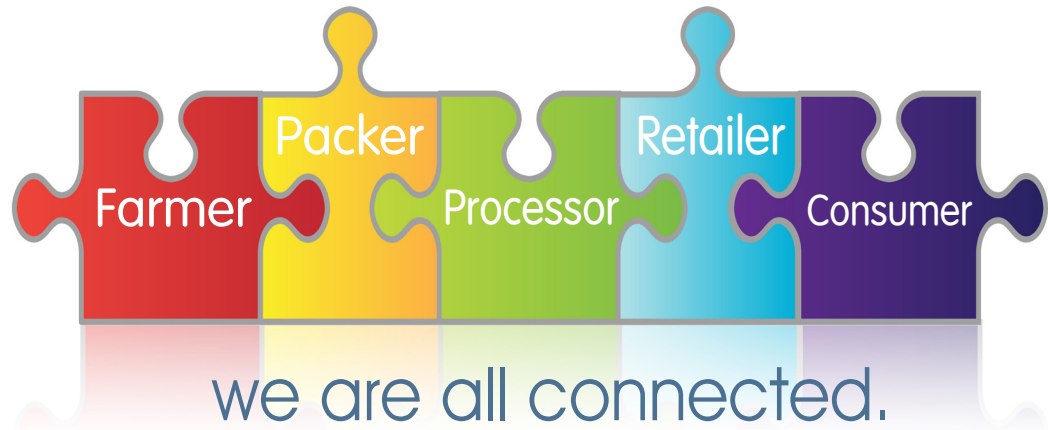

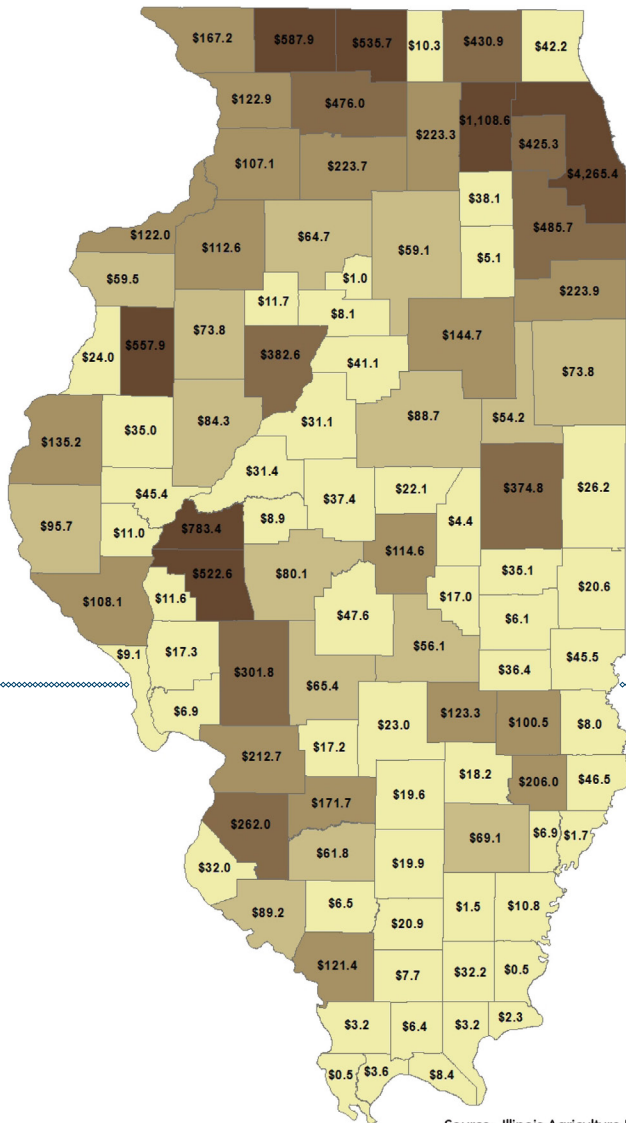
IPPA is more than just a farm organization...
