What is Required?

The Illinois Livestock Management Facilities Act of 1997 requires livestock producers to receive training through the U of I Extension CLM Training Program. This program provides livestock producers with the best management practices for managing and handling their manure. Livestock producers with more than 300 animal units must be a certified livestock manager (CLM).

To become a CLM, producers with 300-999 animal units can attend one U of I Extension CLM Training Workshop or pass the Illinois Department of Agriculture (IDOA) administered CLM exam. Producers with over 1,000 animal units are required to complete **both** the workshop and the IDOA Exam. The IDOA Exam is offered immediately following each of the CLM Workshops.

Upon successful completion of these requirements producers are **certified for three years**.

Workshop Information

On-site workshop sign-in and late registration starts at 8:30 The CLM training will begin promptly at 9:00 am. Please allow 3.5 hours for the workshop, and additional time to complete the IDOA exam if needed.

The registration cost is \$35. If more than one employee from the same farm signs up, each registration after the first will cost \$25. *Coffee and donuts are provided.*

CLM Training Manual

The training manual for this program, in use since 2003, is the National Livestock and Poultry Environmental Stewardship (LPES) Curriculum. We have manuals available for purchase in both paper (\$67.50) and electronic CDs (\$32.50). Please call 1-800-345-6087 to order a copy. The IDOA CLM Exam's questions are taken directly from this manual. Some of this curriculum will be covered during the workshops. However, it is impossible to cover all of the exam material in one workshop, so acquiring and reviewing the
