



FOOD SERVICES GRANT

High school teachers in Illinois may apply to the Illinois Pork Producers Association (IPPA) to receive funding for the purchase of PORK to be used in culinary, food services and consumer education classes.

INSTRUCTIONS: 2019 Fall Semester Application Requirements and Information

- Grants are only available to Illinois high school culinary, food services and consumer education classes for the purpose of educating students about pork production. Pork Production refers to the raising of pigs to provide quality pork people can taste and trust. In addition, the PORK purchased will be used in a recipe of the teacher's choice and prepared by students in said cooking class.
- There are two funding levels (you may only apply for one level):
 Grants up to \$250.00 must be used ONLY for the purchase of PORK. (Recommend less than 30 students reached.)
 Grants up to \$500 must be used ONLY for the purchase of PORK and a pig farmer shall be invited to attend a class to speak with students about pig farming. (Recommend 30+ students reached.)
- Selected schools will receive a welcome packet with information about pork and recipe ideas.
- Receipts showing the purchase of pork must be included with the final report to secure reimbursement of funds.
- APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED BY August 30, 2019. Applications will be reviewed and notification will be made by September 16,2019
- Funds are awarded on a reimbursement basis to the school post cooking class. Activity must be completed prior to December 23, 2019.
